DAY 2

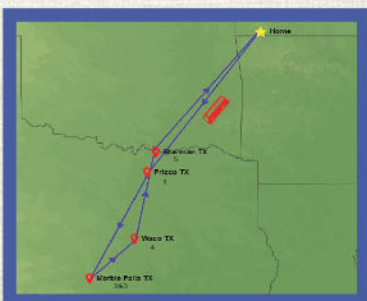

Next, we're off to Waco, TX, where there will be options for you to enjoy, the **Texas Ranger Hall of Fame & Museum** or the **Magnolia Market**. The Texas Ranger Hall of Fame and Museum will both educate and entertain you with history and art. The Magnolia Market will enthuse you with its seasonal inspirations and curated collection. Then our bus will whisk us away from Waco to **Marble Falls, TX**, where we will call our hotel home for the next two nights.

DAY 3

From Marble Falls, we travel to **Fredericksburg** where we'll roam the **Wildseed Farms-Trails and Gardens**. Afterward, we'll hang our hats for the night at our hotel in **Sherman, TX**.
